

priate than weaponry, other equipment may take priority.

Finally, you christen your ship and prepare for takeoff. You must calibrate the navigation system by using a printed trade map of the solar systems that comes with the program. This map helps you navigate about the stars and locate the solar systems marked as having trade centers. These trade centers, markets where you can buy or sell goods, are also the only place to obtain more fuel for your starship. The map indicates the surface temperatures of the planets by color-coding them. Because conditions have to be suitable for landing on a planet, this map is essential for your exploration.

After takeoff, get ready to enter hyperspace, where you see stars, continuum fluxes, and nebulas. The navigator will maneuver your ship as you begin exploration. Options include exploring nearby planets or finding "wormholes" in space which instantaneously transport you from one location to another.

Your trek through space will provide opportunities for many encounters with aliens who know about trade locations and have information essential to the completion of your mission.

Here diplomacy as well as knowledge about the aliens is necessary. Your well-trained science officer will interpret data collected by your ship's sensors, and your communications officer will translate the incoming messages.

Some aliens respond best to a stern posture while others prefer you to be submissive. Make a mistake or have a misunderstanding, and you may be obliterated. Until you are able to buy a strong arsenal and shielding to protect yourself, you are very vulnerable to attack.

Financing this adventure is an ongoing process. Planets along the way can be explored and excavated for minerals and other items of value. Collected while traveling across the surface of the planet in your terrain vehicle and sold at the trade centers, these commodities help you raise needed funds. Trade centers are found by wandering around on the planet. Once you find one, your bartering skills are put to the test.

With 150 star systems and hundreds of planets to explore, 30 alien species to deal with, and an open-ended story line involving numerous subplots, *Starflight 2* will provide you with hours of adventure. So if you're

ready to explore new worlds, board your starship and follow the interstellar trade routes of *Starflight 2*.

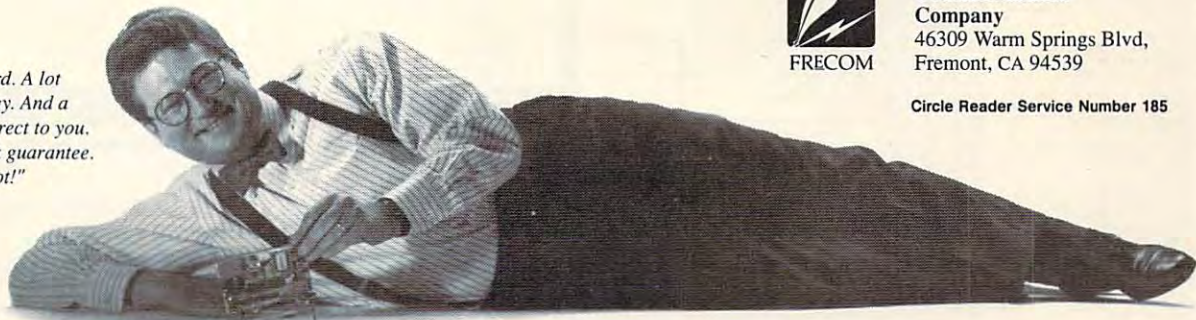

need to customize the program even more, you can add your own grammar and style rules with the new Rule and Help Editor. Imagine feeding your organization's house style into *Grammatik IV*. It boggles the mind.

On a well-written test document of about 300 words, *Grammatik IV* uncovered three genuine and five false errors. I tried *Grammatik III* about a year ago, and it found an even higher proportion of false errors. With the current version, you'll spend less time dealing with red herrings.

Also new to this version is a feature that lets you interactively correct errors from within six popular word processors: *WordPerfect 5*, *Microsoft Word 5.0*, *WordStar 5.5*, *XyWrite III*, *Professional Write 2.1*, and the latest version of *Q & A*. You can run the program from the command line with 33 other word processors.

In addition to the manual, the package includes an excellent book, *Secrets of Successful Writing*, by De Witt Scott. It's filled with useful tips on how to write directly and clearly.

Grammatik IV is easy to use and does a good job of ferreting out many kinds of grammatical gremlins. If you need help with your writing, check out *Grammatik IV*. It may not be perfect, but it will do until *Grammatik V* comes along.

WINDWALKER

A quick duck and the attacker's sword flies harmlessly over your head. The surprised palace guard staggers for the briefest moment to regain his balance. Amazingly, faster than reflexes should allow, you launch your right leg like a battering ram squarely into your attacker's chest. He falls in a heap.

"You landed a powerful blow," flashes the screen. "As the attacker flees he drops some food." Finally, you think to yourself, *a meal...*

Windwalker is full of such encounters, which are part of the path to honor and enlightenment. This fanta-

sy role-playing game is set in ancient China. You begin as a Lowly Fisherman and through good deeds, knowledge, combat, and achievements you can rise in rank to Wolf, Condor, Cobra, and finally Dragon. Your ultimate task is to free the emperor from the rule of the evil warlord and his band of followers who have overtaken the local empire.

This sequel to *Moebius* is much more than the standard role-playing scenario, mixing realtime arcade fighting sequences with a richly detailed, captivating story. *Windwalker* sinks deep in the mystic culture of ancient China, engaging the player in rituals

and disciplines that lead to wisdom, strength, and other goals.

Dozens of smaller tasks, or missions, can lead to success. You must attain your goals while maintaining perfect honor. Stealing, attacking while unprovoked, and even feeling guilty can taint your honor. If this happens, you will be forbidden by the villagers to sleep in their homes, and numerous other factors will work against you.

Honing your martial arts technique is of high priority. Ninja assassins leap from behind rocks, dagger-wielding thieves chase you by boat, palace guards try to carve you with their long swords.

You'll need to learn the discipline of the monks—and quick. Passing this full-day ritual earns you a sacred robe and, more useful, a staff for fighting. Other disciplines award you with even more interesting abilities. Each of the disciplines you learn has its own special prayers, which can bring aid from above. Depending on the phrase you say, prayers can heal your physical wounds, restore your honor, quicken your pace, and so on.

Interact with villagers, who offer advice and clues (sometimes for a fee) and generally steer you in the right direction. The game presents conversational topics through menus.

A particular topic will only ap-

pear on the menu after you're aware of its existence. For example, a fisherman will offer clues about the lost explorer only after you've discovered the explorer's empty home. As the story progresses you should double-check with the key characters in the game to see if they have anything new to say.

The attention to realism even includes the use of human martial arts experts that were videotaped, digitized, and used as models for the full-screen fighting sequences. As a black belt in karate myself, I can verify the authenticity of the game's fighting sequences. However, the animation is not as fluid as in games that are designed strictly as karate competitions.

The graphics in general are outstanding. In most games of this type, you see a small section of the game's world from an aerial perspective. *Windwalker* instead creates a horizon effect by having objects in the distance—mountains, temples, trees, walls—rise into view as you move closer. At the same time, the sky above shows the position of the sun, moon, or storms.

Windwalker is ideal for players new to computer role-playing. It doesn't have an overwhelmingly large play area nor are the puzzles too demanding. In fact, *Windwalker* has so many clues that you nearly always know what to do next. Game designer Greg Malone is on my list of software authors to watch for in the future.

ta attack aircraft; and four Walrus amphibious assault vehicles. Should be a snap, right?

Wrong. The enemy carrier, though similar to yours, has a newer design. You're taking version 1.0 into combat against version 2.0. Also, you need to build a supply-and-defense network on the nearby island chain. Unfortunately, the enemy got a head start and already has a growing network creating supplies, building weapons, and pumping fuel.

Carrier Command has the best blend of arcade and strategy elements I've ever encountered. Combat is fast-paced, rivaling the best flight simulators and tank games. But the strategy is vital—if you don't build a proper defense network, you won't stand a chance in the arcade sequences.

The 3-D graphics are among the smoothest you'll find in a PC game, and you'll appreciate the fast screen updates even on slower machines. The game also boasts very attractive VGA and EGA screens, and the CGA and Hercules graphics are among the best in their class.

So, go save the world again in *Carrier Command*. It's a fun job, but somebody has to do it.

HEADSTART EXPLORER

Every aspect of the HeadStart Explorer has been designed to make computing simple for the new user. The hardware is modular, and the interface is intuitive. In fact, the interface is more than intuitive: It's instructive. But user-friendly technology may not be enough to overcome this computer's shortcomings. Flexibility and power are also valuable assets in a home computer; you shouldn't trade them away without some serious thought.

HeadStart uses a bulletin-board metaphor for its graphical user interface. Each peripheral has an icon, and many programs have icons, too. If you haven't installed a peripheral

properly, the icon doesn't show up; you know you've done something wrong.

The mouse pointer almost always has a little tag attached, telling you what kind of action it's ready to take. For example, in the Bulletin Board, the tag says *Do This*, meaning it's time to do something with whatever icon you clicked on. In the bundled word processor, the pointer is even more helpful. When you need to select text, click on the button that says *Select Text* and the pointer tag says *Start Here*. Once you've clicked on the beginning of the text block you wish to

select, the pointer tag changes to *End Here*. That's what I call a friendly mouse pointer.

When you want to run other software, however, the system isn't as friendly. Insert a game disk in the drive, for example, and the Disk Navigator pops up with a list of files on the disk and a series of buttons for file operations (Copy, Rename, Use This File). Unless your program has been "Explorized," the machine won't recognize the game's executable file. So you must look for the file with the .EXE extension, select it, and then click the Use This File button. New users probably won't recognize an executable file, and their software manuals won't be working on the same wavelength as the Explorer.

You can always hop out of the Bulletin Board and into DOS, of course, but that defeats the purpose of a simple shell. Although the Explorer's bundled software and operating environment seem ideal for neophytes, more experienced users will be left wanting more.

Neophytes will also appreciate the way the hardware works. To add a hard disk, for example, purchase HeadStart's 40-megabyte Automagic Hard Disk. It fits in a specially designed hole on the side of the computer. You never have to look inside

the machine. A HeadStart RAM Pac is the company's answer to simple memory expansion. The whole design smacks of videogame cartridges—proprietary technology that goes against the grain of an open system, which is what standard MS-DOS PC design is all about.

Consider the Explorer's unusual 16-color CGA graphics. The bundled software supports this mode, but no other programs that I tried did. HeadStart is providing software designers with a developer's kit that lets them include drivers for this graphics mode in their programs, but it's just too soon to tell if 16-color CGA will sink or swim.

The Explorer features only one expansion slot (half-size, 8-bit). If you ever want to add more capability to your system, such as a different graphics adapter or a sound card, you'll need an external expansion-slot chassis.

Not many people stay satisfied with their computers once they know what more memory can do, a couple more megahertz of speed can accomplish, or a few hundred more colors can look like. With all of its simplicity and benevolence, with all of its wonderfully designed interfaces and software, the HeadStart Explorer forces you to wonder how long you'll stay a beginner.

If you don't want to move on from your first computing experiences, the Explorer isn't a bad choice. It's designed for beginners, but, unlike its low-end Tandy 1000 competition, it lacks the support network of a corner Radio Shack store and the software support for its orphan graphics standard.

User-friendly technology is simply not enough to justify a computer that uses nonstandard graphics, is difficult to upgrade, and is outgrown quickly. HeadStart has good intentions, and it's not trying to pass this machine off as anything other than a basic beginner's computing tool, but the Explorer is too limited for most people.

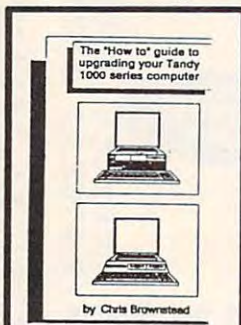

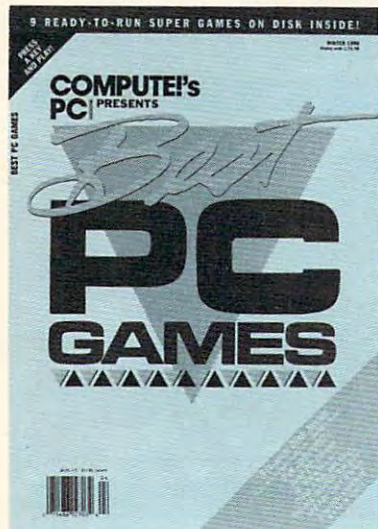

Can software be a viable storytelling medium? Can the PC compete with the printed page?

These questions have been asked since the earliest days of personal computing. The first interactive computer stories—generically known as *adventure games*—were text-based programs with command line parsers that accepted the player's typed input. Graphics added a visual dimension to the storytelling mix, but the stories themselves tended toward rudimentary fantasy-oriented scenarios.

One entertainment software author who has diligently worked to advance the craft of electronic storytelling is Roberta Williams. Co-founder of Sierra, with her husband, Ken Williams, she foresees a day in the not-too-distant future when software stories are as intricate and involved as their paper and celluloid counterparts.

Perhaps best known for her King's Quest series of interactive fantasies, Williams has lately extended her range. *Mixed-Up Mother Goose* places children in an interactive interpretation of famous nursery rhymes. Williams' latest project, *The Colonel's Bequest*, is a gothic murder-mystery set in the 1920s.

"One of the things that we're interested in [doing] is to get away from the term *adventure game*," she says. "It's not a game anymore. On the packaging, we still call our products *animated adventure games*. But internally, we're referring more and more to *interactive entertainment*, or *interactive storytelling*. My goal is to have an interactive story that is still a game—but that's more story than game."

Williams says that while technology makes possible many of the techniques that deepen electronic storytelling—more vivid colors, smoother animation, better sound—the future of interactive entertainment

is more dependent on human creativity and artistic realization than on technological innovation.

"To really have true interactive stories," she says, "we need to have more writers become software designers. I've been a designer for ten years—but I wasn't a writer before that."

"I was always a reader. I was a good storyteller, I think, but I wasn't really a writer. I've had to learn how to write. There are still areas—punctuation—that I'm not comfortable with. I'm still learning."

Artists from traditional storytelling media have much to learn. If the opportunities opened to electronic storytellers are new, so are the constraints placed upon them. In a realistic novel, a character's death is irreversible. In a software story, the player can simply reboot when the plot takes an unwanted turn. Does this affect the seriousness with which an audience approaches interactive stories?

Williams thinks so, and she feels

it's not just the audience who must re-think traditional storytelling orientation. "The freedom and interactivity are the hard part—that's the part a 'true' writer is going to have the most trouble with. They have to learn a whole new way of thinking in order to tell interactive stories. You have to be *very* open-minded with your story."

Having worked with writers and having experienced firsthand their difficulties in coming to terms with interactive techniques, Williams suggests that not every writer will easily make the transition to interactive stories. "Some writers just can't make the leap. They cannot translate stories into interactive experiences," she says. "It's hard to relearn something. It takes the right person to do it."

Other writers will see the medium as a liberation. "I think we're headed toward interactive stories that are as complex and deep as a novel," Williams says.

The same virtues that illuminate good stories play a large role in the future of interactive entertainment.

"For interactive storytelling to go forward," Williams says, "and make leaps in terms of the story's importance, you must have a story that's developed, characters who are developed, a real sense of who you are and what's going on around you. You must really be drawn into the story, rather than just be drawn into the game."

The artists who will make those leaps may not be the traditional computer storytellers. "Currently, I think that most people who are designing games are not really writers. They are people who come from programming, or they were designing arcade games or flight simulators. Now they're trying to convert to telling stories."

Such people, Williams implies, are anachronisms. The future will belong to real storytellers who can master the interactive medium. "This is a very important new form of entertainment," Williams says, "one that's going to be a full-fledged member of the mass-entertainment community." □

People often ask me: "How do you do it? Why is it that you know so much about computers? What makes you different?" My answer: I read the manuals. Unfortunately, those four words are much too short to make a column. So I must describe this quest for computer guru-hood in all its glory. It all starts with becoming a computer nerd.

Becoming a nerd may not top your list of social improvements for the 1990s. Yet, you're going to have to nerd-it if you ever expect to get anywhere with your computer. In the future, being a nerd won't just be necessary to understanding a computer—it will be a national craze.

Society has a silly habit of eventually idolizing those it currently shuns. In America, we have a whole range of heroes who were once considered untouchables, from the cowboy to the gangster to the rock star. Today, the term *nerd* is just a slight stigma. In fact, I lovingly call anyone who enjoys using a computer a nerd. Some hypersensitive, wimpy, gutless, neocompassionate types may still find it derogatory, but it's much better than *geek*, *dork*, or *tech weenie*. (This could get really nasty. Let's stick with *nerd*.)

Years ago, the term *nerd* was attached to people who were basically asocial. They were pale, tall, and lanky, with greasy hair and stick limbs. The nerds of yesteryear were the antijocks, the guys who knew who Brahms was and what $E=mc^2$ stood for. They wore clothes their mother chose for them (and sometimes needed their mother's help while dressing in the morning). Anyone who wore thick glasses or a tie to school counted. In math class, they were the human computers, the Mentats, the Vulcans.

Today, nerds are people who are into computers, regardless of looks. But the old stereotype is hard to shake. I'm not saying that everyone who uses a computer resembles a tackily clothed Greek god. Let me assure you, computer people may not be elected the sexiest men and women by *People* magazine, but there are some good-looking folks hiding behind those Coke-bottle-bottom glasses. Some of us even bathe regularly. And, given some sort of fashion sense, a diet (any diet), and contact lenses, today's computer nerd can quite seamlessly blend into society. (That's a scary thought.)

Even so, you just don't see nerds on boxes of Wheaties, or on the cover of *GQ* or *M*, or in magazine ads or on billboards touting Dewar's scotch (well . . .). But, like the cowboy (who was urbanized and then accepted), computer nerds will eventually become vogue—a future fad. Nerddom will be something to attain, an aspiration. (Not every antihero in society eventually becomes popular, of course. I doubt there will ever be a time when everyone yearns to dress and act like a lawyer.)

But in about ten years, everyone will be dying to dress like the traditional computer nerd of yore. OK,

maybe not everyone. You can skip over the Valley Gal group. I mean, gag me. But today's housewife—in! Teenager—in! Yuppie—in! (Yuppies are all closet nerds, anyhow, buying computers because it's fashionable: "Muffy! The Peersons are coming over. Better move the Compaq SLT into the den!") And finally, the *Cosmopolitan* girl—in, you bet! She'll dress like a nerd, act like one, even attend nerd functions. Why? Because nerds make massive loot!

In ten years, maybe five, we'll all be walking around in Hawaiian shirts and sandals, staying up all night, and saying things like:

"Control-C Me!" *Translation: Give me a break!*

"You're spinning NOPs." *Translation: You're not saying/doing anything.*

"I don't program, I code." *Translation: You're a dweeb. I'm cool.*

Like any fad, nerddom's rise to popularity will be accompanied by a popular prime-time TV show (and I'm not talking Al Bundy here), just as "Miami Vice" started the pastel craze. (I'm still waiting for my Earth-tones to come back in style.) Maybe it will be a spinoff from "Star Trek: The Next Generation" that stars Geordi, Data, and Wesley Crusher as three zany aliens who return to high school in 1979 Vermont.

There will surely be a major motion picture. Forget *Revenge of the Nerds*. I'm talking a superhero movie, something like *Indiana Edwin and the Cray of Doom!*

So, if you want to be a computer nerd, if you're dying to catch the crest of this upcoming fashion wave and lifestyle craze, keep reading this column in the months to come. I'll be addressing such important issues as computer nerd diet, appearance, language, habits, and musical tastes. If you're going to do things properly, if you want to be where it's at before anyone else gets there, this is important stuff. And don't forget that becoming a nerd eventually leads to computer guruhood. □

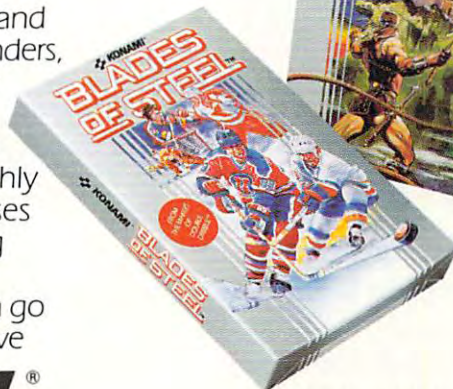
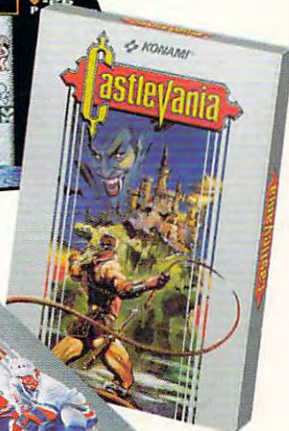

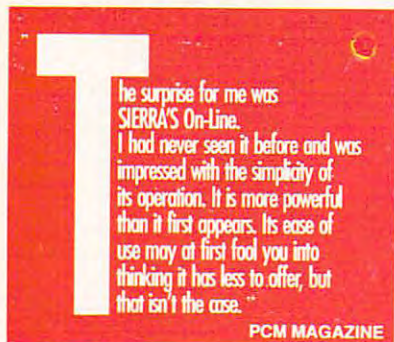
