• The description of Dictionary Manager, Program 1 of "Speed-Check" (December 1985), did not explicitly state that this program creates a blank dictionary disk by *formatting* it. If you type in the program, save it to disk, and then run the program on the same disk, that disk will be formatted and your copy of the program lost.

Those readers who are still using the original *SpeedScript* (January 1984) will have to make a minor change to SpeedCheck. After loading the program, enter **POKE 4242**, **24**. Then save the modified copy of SpeedCheck.

GAZETTE DISK subscribers may have run into a problem with SpeedCheck. If you want to make the modifications for *WordPro* or *PaperClip* listed in the article, the MLX program on the disk will not allow you to load the program on the disk. The solution is to modify MLX. Note that this is not a permanent change, it's a temporary fix to allow loading of SpeedCheck:

1. Load, but don't run MLX.

2. LIST 845-850 and change the final POKE in 845 to **POKE782,0**. Also, add **POKE781,0**: **POKE782,192**: to the beginning of line 850.

3. Run MLX and you'll be able to load SpeedCheck to make the *Wordpro* or *Paperclip* modifications.

One more note about Speed-Check and the GAZETTE DISK: The program requires its own dictionary disk. You cannot load and run it directly from the menu. A program that copies the dictionary files to a new disk is included on the GAZETTE DISK.

• "Auto File" (November 1985) creates a directory reading program called ".DIR." But the program assumes that .DIR is the first program on a disk and the directory it provides doesn't include the first program. This inconvenience can be avoided by moving .DIR to the first place on the directory. Instructions for doing this can be found in the article describing the Auto File program. A quicker solution, however, is to load "Auto File," (do not run), type **POKE 2537,224:POKE 2571, 224** then save the program under a new name. Before running it, you'll have to scratch previously created .DIR files.

• If you turn on your computer, run "Backgammon" (November 1985) and play a game, then turn your computer off and on, load it again, and run it, you'll find that the dice rolls are exactly the same. To fix this, add a line like 1 X = RND(TI/97) at the beginning of the program. For a more detailed description of why this is necessary, see the "Gazette Feedback" item on page 12, top right corner, of the November issue.

• A typographical error appeared in the article about "Digi-Clock" (November 1985). When you run the program, the screen displays SYS 682 to re-enable the clock after pressing RUN/STOP-RESTORE. But the article lists SYS 628. The program message is correct.

• Reader Richard D. Kyle has discovered a glitch in "Power Poker" (November 1985). If you should score more than 1000 points in a game and it becomes the new high score, the screen display of any further games will be slightly off because the length of the high score will print in the last column, causing a new line to open up and the screen to scroll. Although Power Poker was tested extensively, no member of our staff was able to attain a score of 1000 or higher.

Lines 390–420 determine the length (LEN) of the high score and position it properly on the screen. You could modify this routine to allow for scores above 1000, or simply subtract one from each SPC() function in lines 390–420. This problem does not affect the playability of the game and you needn't make these modifications unless you anticipate scoring over 1000.
